

Minutes of the Montpelier City Council Meeting
June 12, 2020 11:30 AM
Videoconference

In attendance: Councilors Jay Ericson, Jack McCullough, Dan Richardson, Conor Casey, Dona Bate, Lauren Hierl and Mayor Anne Watson. City Clerk John Odum acted as secretary.

The Call to Order by the Mayor was at 12:00pm. The Mayor took a moment to clarify some of her comments from the previous meeting.

- 2020-198. The Mayor opened the 2nd reading proposed parklet ordinance. After discussion, the public hearing was closed at 12:04. Councilor Richardson moved the Council approve the temporary parklet ordinance and was seconded by Councilor McCullough. The motion carried unanimously
- 2020-199. A discussion of a proposed Black Lives Matter mural on State Street was opened with the project presented by Ward Joyce. Police Chief Facos participated. After discussion, Councilor Casey moved to approve the design submitted by Ward Joyce and close State Street from Taylor Street to Bailey from the hours of 7:00 in the morning to 2:00 in the afternoon. Councilor Bate seconded. After further discussion, the motion carried unanimously.
- 2020-200. The council discussed further options for supporting the Black Lives Matter movement. Councilor McCullough moved the city obtain a Black Lives Matter flag and fly it in front of City Hall. Councilor Richardson seconded. After more discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Without objection, the Mayor adjourned the meeting by unanimous consent.
