

Minutes of the Montpelier City Council Meeting
July 12, 2021, 6:30pm
City Council Chambers and videoconference

In attendance: Mayor Anne Watson (Chair), Councilors Jack McCullough, Dan Richardson, and Dona Bate. Councilors Lauren Hierl, Jay Ericson, and Conor Casey were not present. City Clerk John Odum acted as secretary.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM.

- 2021-200. Without objection the agenda was approved with the addition of the third class liquor license application for Bent Nails Bistro on Langdon Street.
- 2021-202. After being moved by Councilor McCullough and seconded by Councilor Richardson the Consent Agenda was approved as amended. The passage included approval of the 3rd class liquor license application from Bent Nails Bistro. Motion passed 4-0 with the Mayor voting aye
- 2021-203. Councilor Richardson moved the Council approve setting the Fiscal year 2022 Tax Rate at 1.1807 and setting the water sewer benefit charge of 2 cents and sewer separation charge of 7 cents. Councilor McCullough seconded and the motion carried unanimously (4-0, the Mayor voting aye).
- 2021-204. Councilor Richardson made the following motion: that the City of Montpelier accept its allocation of Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funding from the US Treasury, along with the award terms & conditions and assurances of compliance with the civil rights requirements that are requirements of accepting these funds, second that we appoint William Fraser, City Manager to serve as the City's "Authorized Representative" as required by the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funding from the US Treasury, to sign the award terms & conditions and assurances of compliance with the civil rights requirements by July 15th, and that we name Kelly Murphy, Finance Director to be the "Contact Person" for the City's CLRFR Award from the U.S. Treasury." Councilor McCullough seconded and the motion passes 4-0 (Mayor Watson voting aye).

Without objection, the meeting was adjourned by the Mayor at 6:37PM by unanimous consent.
