

CHAPTER 8
ANIMALS AND FOWL
ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 8-1. RUNNING AT LARGE.

No person owning or who has custody and control of any domestic animal, except cats, shall permit such animal to go at large, loose or unrestricted in any public street within the limits of the City or on any land therein thrown open as a way for public travel and used by the public for travel although such way be not legally a public street, or go at large elsewhere in the City. See Article II of this Chapter for restrictions on dogs running at large.

Sec. 8-2. SADDLED HORSES AND DRAFT ANIMALS.

No saddled horse or draft animal shall be permitted by the owner or person in charge thereof to go into any public street unaccompanied by a driver or leader.

Sec. 8-3. KEEPING LIVESTOCK.

No livestock or other domestic animal shall be kept in such a manner that (1) causes the discharge of manure or other agricultural waste into public waterways, roads, or onto neighboring properties; (2) creates a persistent, offensive odor resulting in the discomfort of neighboring residents; or (3) causes an infestation of rodents, flies, or other wild pests.

Sec. 8-5. POULTRY -- UNLAWFUL TO KEEP EXCEPT IN ENCLOSURE.

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep poultry in the City limits, unless the poultry is confined in a properly fenced enclosure in such a manner that the poultry cannot escape therefrom.

Sec. 8-6. BURYING DEAD ANIMALS.

No person shall bury or cause to be buried the body of any horse or other large animal, within the limits of the city, unless in such manner that every part and portion of such body shall be at least three (3) feet below the natural surface of the ground where the same is buried.
